However, due to the presence of some occupations at the subcategory level with limited number of internet survey respondents, we merged some occupational sub-categories with the adjacent ones, forming new categories for our analysis. These newly formed categories are denoted with "(integrated)" at the end of their names. 2. Furthermore, as indicated in the <u>vielnov call</u>. Tystem consultants, designers' and "software creators' have been excluded from the occupations. This exclusion aims to prevent double counting because they are used in the estimation of the output of in-house developed software.
3. Data used in-house for lens than one year is included inside the production of data assets, although this does not align with the current System of National Accounts (SNA) treatment on intermediate consumption on its own account.
