Federal Parliamentarians who are women




Informal votes in Australian Federal Elections









The area of '**Governance**'

- The systems, processes and institutions which govern, administer and regulate human activity, especially in respect of the impact on individual or societal **wellbeing**
- Refers to the way these arrangements **operate** (eg, how they are managed) and to
- the **inclusion**, in decision-making, of those whose lives may be affected (eg, via consultative or representative processes)




