


# No country performs best in all dimensions

Number of green lights out of 22 headline indicators




Number of red lights out of 22 headline indicators



# Inequalities in well-being: health


## Low-income people report lower health status




# Inequalities in well-being: social connections

Percentage of people reporting that they have someone to count on in times of need, 2010


Percentage of people reporting trusting others, 2010


