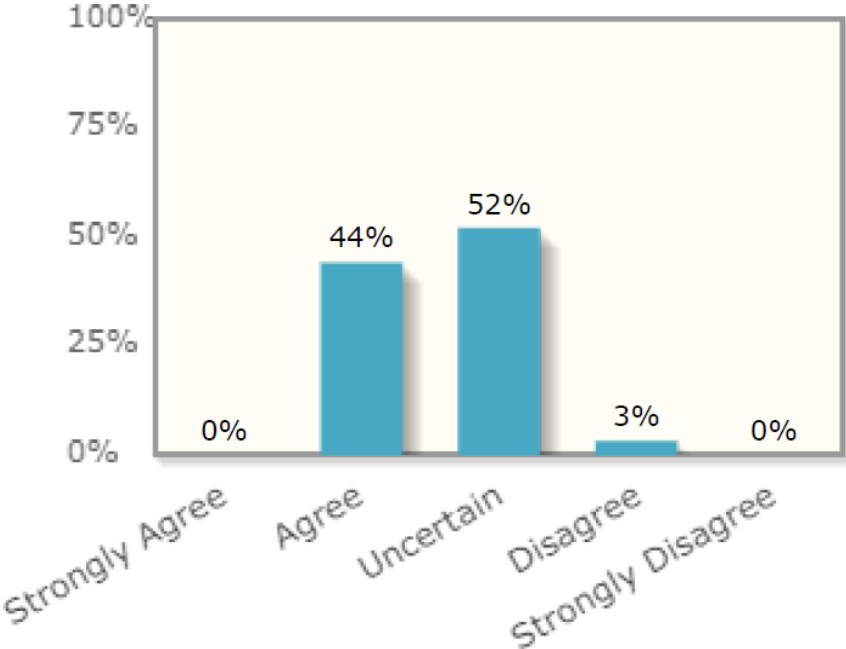


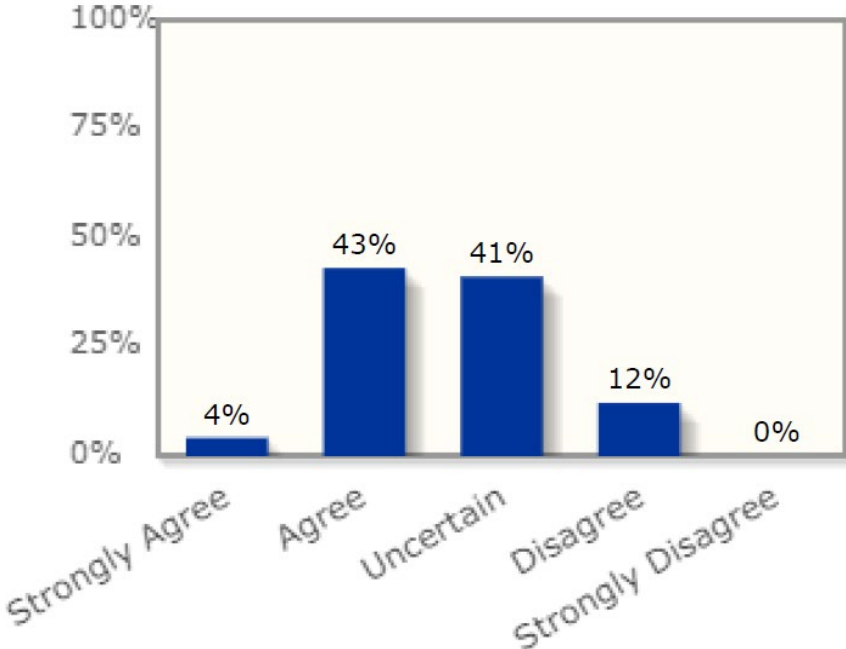
March 12, 2020 Poll Question

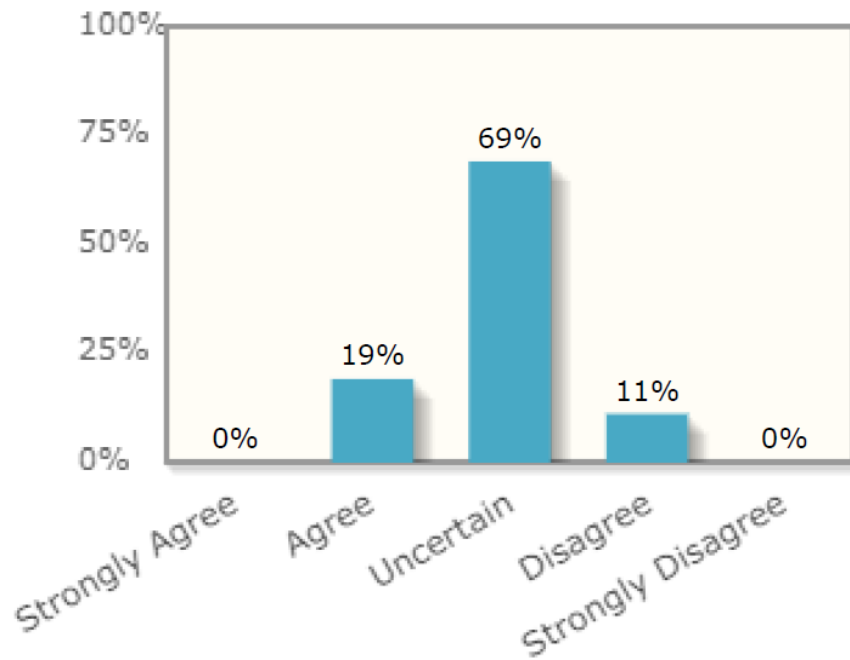

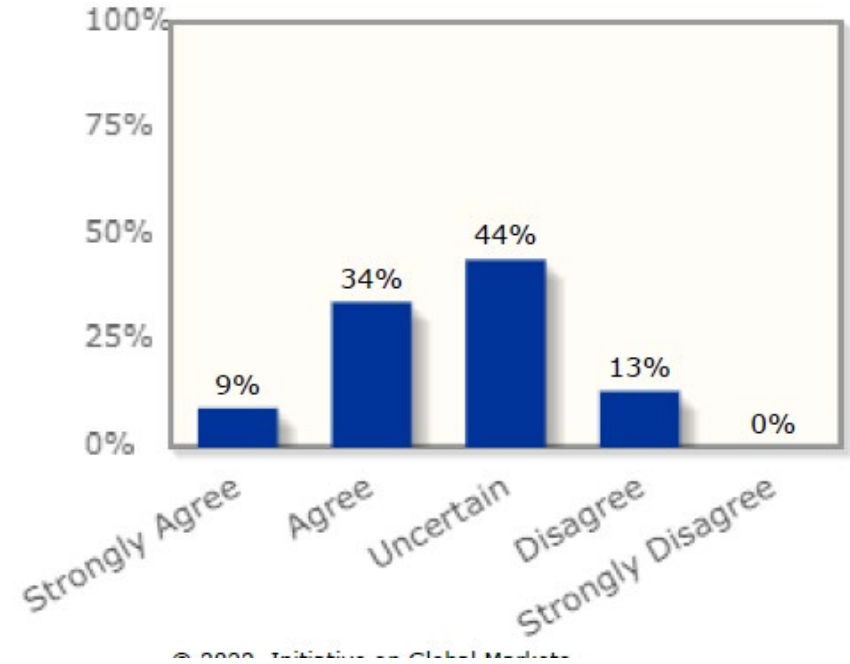
January 28, 2022 Poll Question

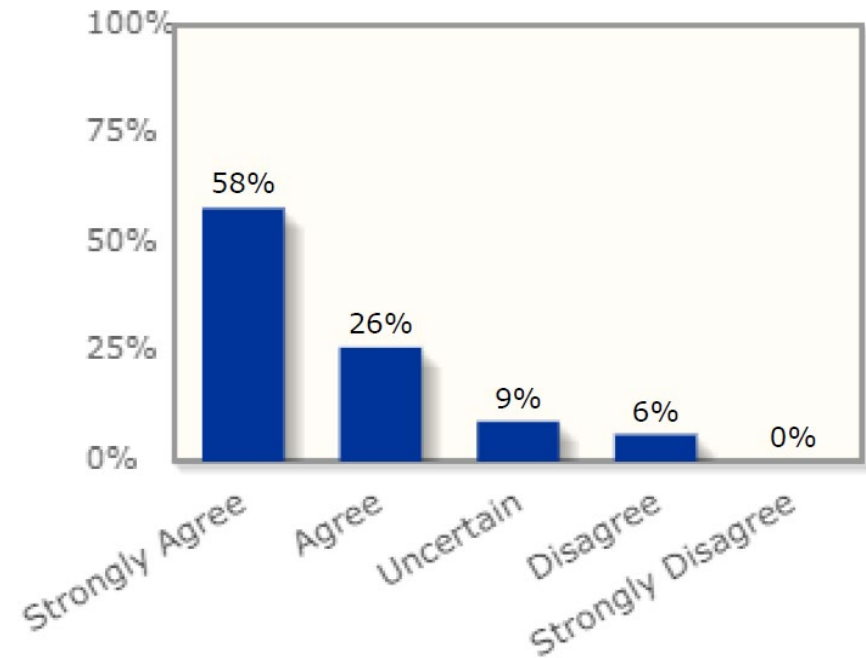
April 14, 2020 Poll Question
